The parish council meets in public in St Keyne Village Hall or Trewidland Village Hall on the second Wednesday of each month, except for August and December. Member of the public are welcome at Parish Council meetings, and can speak, if they wish, during Public Participation. And if you are unable to attend but wish to comment on the agenda, email the Clerk in advance and your comments will be included in the appropriate part of the discussion. The shaded box indicates a meeting at Trewidland; the clear boxes are for meetings held in St Keyne.

How do I know what is going to be discussed?

We publish the agenda of our public meetings at least three working days beforehand so you can see what we are discussing. Residents are always welcome to attend public meetings as observers or to take part. There's no need to give notice, but if you are attending and want to comment on any of the items on the agenda or raise an issue with the councillors, time is set aside at the start of every meeting for you to speak.

How do I know what has happened during a meeting?

We publish minutes of all our public meetings within two weeks of the meeting itself. You can always find a copy on display on the parish noticeboard. Copies of the full minutes from each meeting are available on the website or from Parish Clerk.
