Project proposal

1 Background

The St Keyne annual Produce Show used to be held in St Keyne Village Hall, organised by St Keyne Garden Club. However, the Garden Club has decided to discontinue the Produce Show due to lack of attendance.

I am hoping to run a much scaled down event with the help of the green team and St Keyne village hall and any other volunteers that would like to help.

2 Project Summary

I propose that we fund a grow bag and sunflower seeds as well as vegetable seeds for every primary school age child in our parish. In August, we then hold a small "show" where the children can exhibit what they have grown.

3 Benefit to Residents

This would encourage children and parents to participate in future events like an annual produce show, but also fit in with the green team, trying to engage with growing our own food


4 Cost

The estimated cost per child is £3.50, grow bags in Poundland are £2.50, plus seeds

With an average of 60 eligible children, the total would be around £210

If we are to include all children attending Trewidland school too, the cost will rise accordingly
