Present: Cllr Sarah Whiting (Chair); Cllrs Lindsey Ellis; Jonathan Ellis; Martin Cluer; Patricia Hopwood; Mark Featherston. Also, present Parish Clerk John Hesketh and Cornwall Councillors Jane Pascoe and Mark Gibbons. There were 5 members of the public present.

051/2025 Chair's Welcome & Housekeeping

052/2025 Apologies

Apologies received from Cllr Kevin Shovelton.

053/2025 Declarations of interest

Chair declared an interest in Item 056/2025 (PA25/06144), although no consultation is required. No other declarations of interest made, or dispensations requested

054/2025 Public Participation

A resident attended to raise issues of Public Rights of Way in Trewidland, their maintenance and access. The Chair declared an interest at this point because part of the PROW includes land in her ownership. Councillors discussed this matter but agreed that Cllr Shovelton was best placed to manage the resident's concerns.

Action: Clerk to pass resident's contact details to Cllr Shovelton. Add this item to the October agenda.

A resident attended to record concerns about the recent fire at Lean Quarry and the operation of the facility by Biffa Waste Management. Cllr Gibbons agreed to speak with the resident outside of the meeting and report back as a matter of wider interest.

Action: Clerk to pass resident's contact details to Cllr Gibbons.

Cornwall Councillor Jane Pascoe reported that: the recent partial road closure in St Keyne had caused less disruption than anticipated, and although substantially completed, may need some additional works in November; other maintenance works at Penhale Lane have been completed successfully; full council meeting on 16 September will consider increasing car parking charges by 6%, which Cllr Pascoe will oppose. Cllr Mark Gibbons reported that: the Good Growth Programme had successfully completed its first round of grant funding; backed a motion to recognise Cornwall as a fifth nation within the UK; has been in constant contact with Biffa Waste Management concerning the recent fire (see Item 58A below); is in contact with portfolio holder for transport about bus service number 73 (Liskeard to Polperro via St Keyne) to make it more sustainable.

058/2025 Chair's Report

A Lean Quarry fire

Reported that the recent fire had impacted a much wider area beyond Horningtops. There were delays in tackling fire because of an unsafe roof and extra crew were needed who had to be called from Somerset; pollution (smoke and dust) carried north east towards Menheniot; concerns about plastic pollution into the River Seaton from runoff. Lack of communication between Biffa, Environment Agency and parish council needs to be addressed for future events. Cllr Gibbons posted what information he had on his Facebook page and would now link into the parish council's social media.

Action: Clerk to review Community Emergency Plan with Cllr Shovelton

B Cornwall Fire and Rescue Service Consultation

Completed online survey that asked for views on staffed/unstaffed stations, community communications, and how safety awareness might be best promoted. Results will be published April 2026.

B Cllr Martin Cluer

Outlined his proposal to set up a volunteer network across the parish to provide support our more vulnerable residents. References were made to work being carried out in Looe by former Cornwall Councillor Armand Toms, and similar projects in Yelverton.
