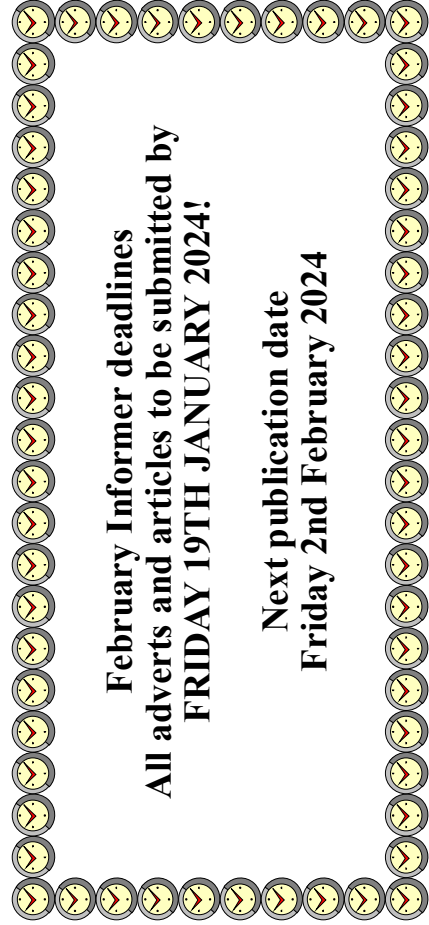

ST KEYNE VILLAGE HALL

The Village Hall is warm and comfortable with a popular Social Club which is open at weekends and bank holidays. It consists of a large hall, a well equipped kitchen, a large meeting room and a small office, all of which are available for hire. The Social Club is available for use by members. It can be made available for a private non-members party provided the hirer obtains a TEN licence.

The hall is available for private hire for birthday parties and other celebrations. The Hall has a PRS licence and professional disco setup with lasers and other lighting effects, smoke machine and bubble machine which can also be hired for events in the hall.

The Village Hall is a registered charity, number 282564, for the benefit of the residents of St Keyne and the local area. It raises funds for its upkeep from the hire charges for the Hall and profit from the bar. The Charity does not work with any professional fund raisers, does not have any trading subsidiaries and does not make any payments to the trustees.

The Village Hall trustees are: Peter Higgs (Chair), Stephanie Holman, Stuart Houghton.

Regular Village Hall Committee Meetings are held on the 1st Wednesday of every month. Meetings start at 7.30pm and are held in the Club with entry via the main Village Hall door. Members of the public are welcome to attend and observe as well as bring up any comments or suggestions at the beginning of the meeting. The Main Hall, Kitchen and Meeting Room are all available to hire. If you are hiring the Village Hall for a party or other celebration, we also have a professional disco setup with lighting effects which you can hire for your event.

Use of the Social Club can also be made available for members of the Social Club. If the hirer wishes to use the bar facility but is not a member of the Social Club and has no intention of joining, the hirer must obtain a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) from Cornwall Council. 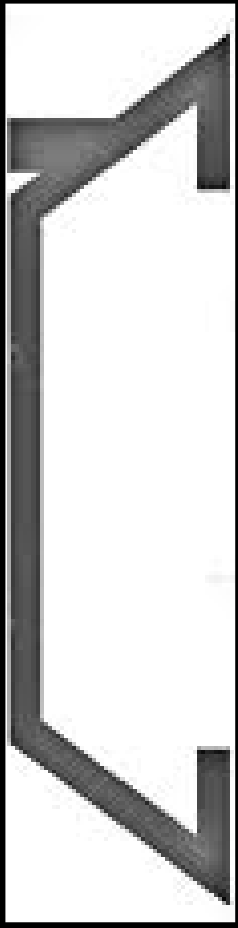

Jubilee Park

Part of Jubilee Park (outside the Play Area) is set aside for dog owners to exercise their pets. Some users may not be aware that the removal of anything left on the grass and the emptying of the bins in the Park is not carried out by Cornwall Council but by local volunteers who then have to dispose of the contents. Only the dog bins on the main road are emptied by Cornwall Council. To make the volunteers' task as painless as possible, dog owners are requested to make sure they clear up after their animals and put the bagged-up waste in the bin - the vast majority do, but there are one or two who could perhaps do a little more.

Please also do not take dog waste from your home and put in the park bin. It should be disposed of with your own domestic waste or put in the designated dog waste bins situated around the village which are emptied by the County Council on a regular basis. 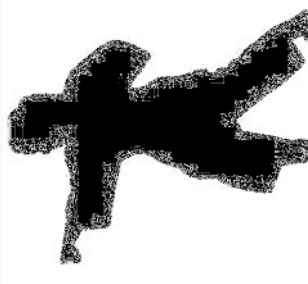

The Non-Psychic 'Psychic' Show

'Psychic' performances are everywhere these days – with people who claim the ability to communicate with the dead performing in everywhere from theatres, to home visits, and on television.

What, however, for those who are interested in the idea of these 'psychic' shows, but are skeptics? Or would like to see how much 'psychic' phenomena can easily be faked?

That is why magician, escapologist and comedy performer Greg Chapman created his 'The Non-Psychic 'Psychic' Show', and is very excited to be coming to the Trewidland Village Hall with the show!

Using the full range of magic, escapology, mentalism and other performance skills, he takes the audience through a ninety-minute exploration of fraudulent mediums, from the Victorian Seances to modern psychic readings, but all clearly presented as trickery – and without any attempt or illusion of talking to people's "dead relatives".

NB: Please note that no refreshments will be served at this performance. Feel free to bring your own, but please no alcoholic beverages.

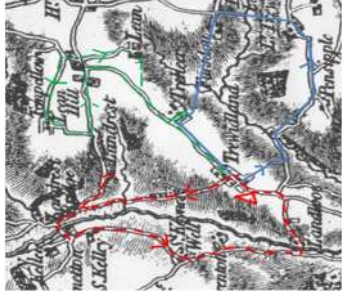

Trewidland Local History Group
 The Trewidland Local History group was set up in November 2013 after the first Local History walk - organised as a means of bringing people together to share local knowledge and their interest in local places and their histories.

Several Members of the original group had already undertaken their own research from the Cornish Archaeology and Cornish Records Office collections (then in Truro) and other published information, and we had the benefit of access to personal collections of photographs and family history (including the collection of the late Mrs Evelyn Woodman).

This led to the preparation for and organisation of further Local History Walks open to all local people to
 Lanreast and Landlooe - October 2013
 Trehere and Tempellow - June 2014
 Lake and Pensipple - July 2015
 Landlooe and Plashford - March 2018



The collation of historical material developed by the group was Exhibited in the Trewidland Shop window as part of 'National Local History Month' in May 2014 and most recently updated, post Covid, by the current display, thanks to Doug and Denise Payas.

Contact with the St Keyne Local History group, Liskeard Museum, and Cornwall Records Office and support from the Cornish Archives Network (now based at Kresen Kernow in Redruth) encouraged us to set up the Trewidland History Archive which has been stored in Trewidland Village Hall since 2016.

The group currently has seven active members who have just recently started to meet again but welcomes anyone with interest in Local History to join us. We hope to hold an AGM in March 2024 to celebrate our tenth anniversary and to hold our next group meeting in January 2024 so if you are interested in making contact, please email Mhairi Mackie at

A Parish Council Round up

We welcomed two new Parish Councillors onto the Parish Council this year following the resignations of Sally Lewis and Peter Higgs. Welcome to Roger Cook, of Trewidland, and Patricia Hopwood from St. Keyne. It's a positive reflection on our community that new people come forward to volunteer serving as Parish Councillors. Thank you both.

What a glorious afternoon was had by all on Saturday May 7 to celebrate the Coronation of King Charles III. Both our Village Halls were full to bursting! The Parish Council sponsored the events but 'Hats Off' to the merry bands of volunteers who set everything up and ran the events. I managed to get to both St. Keyne and Trewidland events and I really enjoyed taking part in such happy and lively community events.

Cornwall Council always asks the Parish Council to consider and comment on all local planning applications. We take this seriously and we do appreciate our discussions with the applicants who come along. There has only been one application that we have strongly objected to – an area of woodland along the lane between Trussel Bridge and St. Keyne Station which has been cleared for use as a storage and maintenance site for construction vehicles and machinery. Cornwall Council agreed with our objections and so did the Independent Appeal judge, so we are expecting these decisions will be enforced and the site will be cleared and no longer be an eyesore. It seems to be taking a while though for action to happen...

We have been working with Cornwall Council to improve the safety for road users on the B3252 through our Parish following the tragedy of two fatal accidents in June 2022 and July 2023 on the stretch of road near Bylane End. We are pleased that Cornwall Council Highways have agreed to upgrade the road signs and road markings at both the Homingtops and Bylane End junctions. These will hopefully provide a better warning for drivers approaching both crossroads. We are continuing to work with the Police, Highways and the Road Safety Team to explore what more can be done. A full report is on our Parish Council website.

You may have noticed we've been continuing to improve our local scene...there's a lovely new entrance to the Lawn Cemetery next to St. Keyne Church, designed and made by a local Joiner. And there's a splendid new noticeboard for Trewidland outside the Village Hall.

We have adopted a 'Safeguarding Policy' for the first time from July this year. We commit ourselves to safeguard and promote the welfare of children, young people and adults by identifying and supporting those who may be suffering harm. The new procedures we've put in place have already enabled us to respond to two incidences of potential harm and support those involved through contact with the relevant Agencies. Our new Safeguarding policy is on the Parish Council website. And finally, not only are we putting time, energy and resources into this new 'Informer' magazine, but we have also launched a Parish Council Facebook page! We already have over 50 followers after just 3 weeks...so if Facebook is your thing why not 'follow' us and be the first to find out Parish Council news and events!

POSTPONED EVENT:

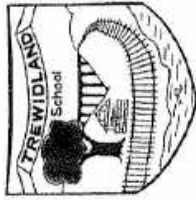

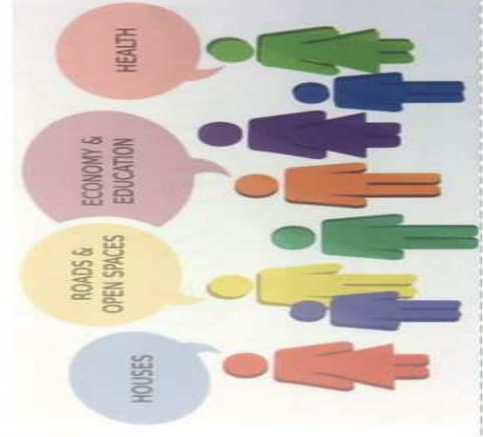
GET READY TO VOTE!!!
