Cllr Whiting reported that: Thanked Cllrs Lindsey & Jonathan Ellis for their support as Vice Chairs, and John Hesketh in his continuing role of Parish Clerk. To Cornwall Councillors Jane Pascoe and Mark Gibbons – the latter for so ably stepping into the shoes of Armand Thomas.</p> <p>The small (.6%) increase in the precept was due to a slight reduction in the number of homes paying local taxes in the parish.</p> <p>Thanks Cllr Hopwood has donated the use of a laptop, is maintaining our parish council Facebook page and is a key driver in the quarterly Informer newsletter, along with Cllrs Shovelton and Lindsey Ellis.</p> <p>Pleased that we have been able to support the Cornwall Air Ambulance, Liskerrett Centre and Trewidland School with donations. Have also supported Trewidland Village Hall with funds to replace their windows.</p> <p>Our Green Team continues to progress environmental improvements: fruit trees in Jubilee Park and Trewidland School and donations of seeds and compost to that school.</p> <p>Cllr Shovelton has worked to maintain and improve our network of footpaths, and updated the Community Emergency Plan.</p> <p>Thanks all residents who attended a public meeting to discuss future planning schemes for St Keyne ward, and looks forward to their continued involvement in the creation of a Neighbourhood Priority Statement.</p> <p><i>The full report may be viewed on the council's website</i></p>
