074/2026 Chair's Welcome & Housekeeping / Dynnargh an Kaderyer ha Kempennans
The Chair welcomed all Councillors and visitors to the meeting.

075/2026 Apologies / Diharesow
Cllrs Jonathan Ellis; Mark Featherston. Cornwall Councillors Jane Pascoe & Mark Gibbon.

076/2026 Declarations of interest / Diskleryansow mell
No declarations of interest made or dispensations requested.

077/2026 Public Participation / Kevrennans poblek
Cllr Pascoe sent a written note, reporting that: the last South East Cornwall Community Area partnership was well attended where she was re-elected as Chair, thanking Cllr Featherston for his support; the meeting included an update from National Highways about proposals to improve junctions on the A38 – please look out for future consultations; concerns raised about the impact of diversions onto unclassified rural roads; the Tamar Bridge TAG committee has voted against an increase in the TAG administration fee; was please to see so many people at the Trewidland Village Fair on 5 July and congratulated the organisers for the event.

A resident attended to ask about progress to clear a footpath in Trewidland that had been blocked by a fallen tree since February 2026. Clerk explained that the council had only been made aware of this on 30 June and since that had spoken directly to Cornwall Highways team who agreed to clear it. Updates on progress are available on the parish council's website. Cllr Shovelton explained that an adjacent footbridge was also concerning and suggested that the footpath may have been closed on account of the bridge (and not the fallen tree).

Another resident commented on proposals to install yellow lines by the post box in Trewidland and argued that parking in the village was a long standing issue and that access to and from local businesses was sometimes problematic. PCSO Steve Edser explained that there was currently no unlawful parking in this area because drivers are able to manoeuvre around potential obstructions, neither is there an issue with visual barriers in the approach to the nearby road junction. In the past month, two incidents in the parish have been reported to the police (details published monthly on the parish Facebook page). He will attend the next coffee morning in St Keyne Village Hall on Wednesday 26 August.

The Chair led an extended discussion on its original decision to send an Expression of Interest to Cornwall Highways to install double-yellow lines in Trewidland village. This follows up item 065/2026 discussed at the last public meeting. The council has encouraged residents to comment on these proposals and it was **Resolved to withdraw its application for funding** to install these lines: this project will not proceed. Proposed Cllr Whiting. Seconded Cllr Lindsey Ellis. All agreed.

Action: Clerk to inform Cornwall Highways of this decision.

D Trewidland Village Hall rebuilding programme

It was **Resolved to approve acceptance of a quotation from Bright Environment** to carry out a bat survey as part of the preparation for rebuilding the hall. Proposed Cllr Shovelton. Seconded Cllr Lindsey Ellis. All agreed.

Action: Clerk to inform Trewidland Village Hall, Bright Environment and issue a purchase order for the survey.
